5.0 Estimated project costs

A broad review of potential costs for the 16 key projects has been undertaken in order to determine baseline project budgets to inform funding applications and s.106/278 negotiations. A predicted scope of typical proposed construction activities is set out in Table 5.1 below, followed by a broad square metre rate and cost for each of the 16 projects. For the purposes of this study and to keep the process clear and simple, square metre rates have been categorised into 5 rate bands, ranging from the lowest band for projects that are partially complete and may only require a lower level of investment, to the highest band for undeveloped sites that would benefit from high quality hard surface finishes and an additional allowance for extra over high cost items (e.g. Project 5, with bridge refurbishment work, carriageway/ junction realignments and controlled crossings etc). Areas have been calculated in square metres, by measuring the length, and allocating a typical width for each route. Typical route lengths and widths have been provided in the table 5.1 below.
