What prior knowledge, experience and qualifications will I need to join the course?	You will need to have reading and writing skills at Entry Level 2. This includes being able to read and write simple and compound sentences and contribute to discussions on familiar topics.
Course Summary:	This course is an introduction to reading, writing, speaking and listening at Entry Level 3 of the adult literacy core curriculum. Learners will understand how to identify main points from straightforward texts, organise writing in short paragraphs, as well as developing effective speaking and listening skills to make relevant contributions to discussions on familiar topics.
What teaching methods will the teacher use?	The tutor will demonstrate and explain skills, and support you to make progress towards your goals.
What assessment methods will the teacher use?	The tutor will assess your skills at the beginning and the end of the course to evidence your progress.
What extra work will be required out of class time?	Completing homework will ensure you make good progress.
