What prior knowledge, experience and qualifications will I need to join the course?	You will need to have literacy skills assessed at entry Level 1 which will be assessed at interview - priority will be given to learners who have successfully completed the introduction course in term 1.
Course Summary:	During this course you will learn to: speak, listen, and respond in discussions; read and understand short texts, signs and symbols; write compound sentences using conjunctions; use punctuation correctly and spell common words correctly.
What teaching methods will the teacher use?	You will work together in small groups of no more than 12 learners. The tutor will demonstrate and explain new skills and support you to make progress towards your goals.
What assessment methods will the teacher use?	Your skills will be assessed at the start of the course and you will take a mock exam in week beginning 23 March and final exam in week beginning 8 June 2020.
What extra work will be required out of class time?	Completing homework will enable you to make good progress.
What materials will I need for the course and how much will they cost (approximately)?	Pens, lined paper, ring binder – all widely available at affordable prices
