



London Borough of Lewisham – Development Management Local Plan - Adoption Statement

In accordance with regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that Lewisham Council adopted the Lewisham Development Management Local Plan on the 26 November 2014. The Development Management Local Plan sets out additional planning policies to guide decisions on planning applications where locational or site-specific provision has not been outlined in the Core Strategy or the London Plan.

An independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government considered the local plan at an Examination in Public held on 26 February 2014.

The Inspector's report was received by the Council on 23 July 2014 and required sixteen main modifications. These modifications are referred to as 'main modifications' (MMs). The full schedule of modifications can be found on the Council's website:

The Development Management Local Plan will replace, in part, the Lewisham Unitary Development Plan (2004), as saved under the provisions laid out in Section 38 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Development Management Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power and / or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting with the date on which the Development Management Local Plan was adopted.
