# Funding





## 6.0 Funding

Implementation of Phase 1 of the North Lewisham Links project was part funded through a £4.4m grant from London Thames Gateway that delivered a number of projects over the period 2008/2009 - 2010/2011. Given the current public funding situation it is likely that projects identified through this Update will be delivered principally through s.106 contributions from development sites, however the Council will seek funding from a variety of sources when bringing forward priority routes and supplement s.106 contributions with funding from other sources as and when available.

S.106 contributions are secured at an appropriate level to mitigate the impact of a development and may be in the form of financial contributions to the Council to procure works or 'works in kind' undertaken by the developer as part of the development. Financial contributions may be used to implement specific projects, or part fund delivery of a larger project that draws on contributions from a number of sites. In the case of works in kind, this is likely to include public realm improvement works in the vicinity of their site or implementing part of a strategic project that is related to the site. The potential funding for the delivery of Links projects could therefore come from more than one source and also funding may be directed to more than one project.

A preliminary review of the 16 projects in terms of potential s.106 funding has been undertaken. The projects and potential funding sources are set out in Table 6.1 below. At this stage the detailed cost of works for the long list of 16 projects has not been estimated but it is likely that additional funding beyond that secured through s.106 contributions will be required to secure their delivery. As these sources have not yet been identified this means that within an overall strategy for the area there needs to be some flexibility in the prioritisation and timing of the delivery of projects.

### **Project implementation**

The planning permissions/s.106s for the Plough Way, Surrey Canal Triangle and Oxestalls Road/Deptford Wharves Strategic Sites, plus those for other sites such as Neptune Wharf/Grinstead Road, Yeoman Street, Wardells Grove and the emerging proposals for Convoys Wharf all include financial contributions to public realm improvements and/or works in kind that will improve the public access and the local environment around the sites. These are summarised below.

Drawing on these funds and the design of associated public realm, works will deliver major local improvements that form part of the network of links within the Deptford and New Cross area. As well as direct Council input to projects through financial contributions in the s.106s towards off-site works (such as works to the former Grand Surrey Canal - Project 10) it is appropriate that the scope and timing of works 'in kind' is monitored and where possible managed by the Council. This will help ensure that the works complement the overall Links strategy and also that the opportunity these sites offer in terms of delivering local public realm improvements achieve maximum impact. Some of the projects (and other smaller scale schemes) will also involve the Council as landowner and will allow for input into scheme design and implementation. In addition, such cases potentially provide an opportunity to achieve a more comprehensive approach to the works through the inclusion of adjacent land and coordination with Council transport, housing and other funding programmes.
