
Our induction programme

The quality of the support and guidance that you will receive in your first year is our top priority.

As a Lewisham NQT you will be supported by an induction programme, which begins in the school with a personal mentor. Together, you will evaluate your progress against the Teachers' Standards. You will also have opportunities to attend continuing professional development sessions where you can meet regularly with other NQTs and develop your professional knowledge and skills.

The induction programme underpins the assessment process that helps you successfully complete your induction period. It provides a firm foundation to develop a successful career in teaching and helps identify a professional development pathway as you move into your second year. 
...a great place to live

Great transport links

There are great transport links too, with central London only a 15-minute train journey away. The Docklands Light Railway connects the borough to the City and Canary Wharf. The London Overground Line provides direct services from Highbury & Islington in north London through several stations in the borough to Crystal Palace and West Croydon in the south and Clapham Junction in the south-west. This is ideal if you want to visit the shops or sample the night life in the west end, Brick Lane, Spitalfields Market and Hoxton – to name just a few.
