

PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004 AND TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL PLANNING) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that Lewisham Council adopted **the Lewisham Planning Obligations Supplementary Planning Document** at the meeting of the Full Council held on 25th February 2015. The SPD sets out the Council's approach to seeking planning obligations from developers proposing new development in the borough after the adoption of the Community Infrastructure Levy Charging Schedule comes into effect on 1st April 2015.

Any person with a sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. However, any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

The consultation draft SPD was changed as a result of representations received during the consultation period. The main changes made are identified in the Consultation Statement.
