In accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that Lewisham Council adopted the **River Corridor Improvement Plan Supplementary Planning Document** at the meeting of the Full Council held on 25th November 2015.

The SPD provides guidance relating to the rivers and river corridors in this borough and seeks to secure high quality development along the river corridors, whilst balancing the objectives for environment protection and enhancement, flood risk, housing supply and economic growth.

Any person with a sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. However, any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted. The consultation draft SPD was changed as a result of representations received during the consultation period. The main changes made are identified in the Consultation Statement.
