

Schedule of recommended <u>main modifications</u> to Site Allocations Local Plan (Proposed Submission version)

## **Recommended main modifications**

Table 1 details the main modifications that the Council are recommending to be made to the Proposed Submission version of the Site Allocations Local Plan. The Council consider that modifications are required either as a result of representations made to the Proposed Submission version consultation, as a response to the National Planning Policy Framework (published in March 2012) or to fix errors or omissions in the Proposed Submission version. A 'track changes' version of the Submission Site Allocations Local Plan has been produced to ensure the recommended changes can be easily viewed in the plan context (see SALP1.19).

The recommended modifications have been assessed by the Council and are not considered to change the intent of any policy significantly. Therefore, there has been no reason to make any changes to the existing versions of supporting documents, including the Appropriate Assessment (SALP1.3), the Equalities Analysis Assessment (SALP1.5) or the Proposals Map Changes Document (SALP1.6). This means the Proposed Submission versions of these documents have been used to support both the Submission Version (SALP1.1) of the Site Allocations Local Plan and the 'Track Modifications' Version (SALP1.19) containing the Council's recommended modifications.
