2. Soundness

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Closure of the Ladywell Leisure Centre cannot be justified. The Lewisham Infrastructure Delivery Plan (as of August 2010) indicates that there will be shortfall of 600sq.m. of swimming space by 2026, given the expected growth in population, if the current provision of 12.63sq.m. per head of population is to

be maintained. According to Table 6.10 in the Infrasturcture Delivery Plan, Ladywell Leisure Centre comprises 572.5sq.m. so is needed to meet the requirement. Given an expected increase of population of 5,460 in the Lewisham Town Centre area (Loampit Vale, Thurston Road, Gateway) and given that the Loampit Vale Leisure Centre will prove attractive to a wider population given its proximity to transport links, Ladywell Leisure Centre is required for swimming.
