Dear Claire, I refer to our telephone conversation today regarding Lewisham's site allocation submission to the Inspector.

I wish to object to the inclusion of our site at Honor Oak Covered Reservoir as a site of nature conservation importance.

The Council has produced no evidence to substantiate their claim that it is a site of nature conservation importance and are solely relying on old surveys which are out of date and therefore no longer relevant.

We also contend that the site is a brownfield site, i.e. previously developed land under current planning guidelines, and we consider this site to be suitable for residential development.

I appreciate that we are outside of the deadline for objections but I would be most grateful if you could please forward our objection to the Inspector.
