This virtual meeting was convened in response to a proposal by the Westcombe Society for amendments to the BJWP Constitution. The amendments had been circulated in advance and previously discussed as follows:

2. OBJECTS

- (a) To act as a forum for the Councils of the Boroughs of Lewisham and Greenwich (hereinafter called "the Councils") and other organisations having an interest in the metropolitan common land within Blackheath (hereinafter called "the Heath"), which is a designated Site of Metropolitan Importance for Nature Conservation (SMINC).
- (g) To advise on, monitor, support and promote the implementation of the two Councils' core policies for nature conservation in relation to the Heath's widely significant ecology. (see Memorandum on Nature Conservation on Blackheath for more details)
- (h) To inform other interested organisations, including all those that are allowed to hold events on Blackheath, of its natural characteristics and to engage such organisations in its protection and long-term conservation.

The amendments were agreed unanimously and without further discussion by all voting members present.
