



A New Neighbourhood Forum for Sydenham Hill

Residents in and around Sydenham Hill are interested in setting up a Neighbourhood Forum to enhance the character of the area, tackle planning issues and create links on both sides of the 'ridge' – from the top of Westwood Hill along to the Horniman triangle. This area falls within two boroughs – Lewisham & Southwark – and three wards: Dulwich Wood, Forest Hill & Sydenham. St Philip Neri school

A public meeting about the new St Philip Neri school development was held at Sydenham Library on Thursday 19 July, chaired by local councillor, Tom Copley and attended by Viv Evans, Lewisham's interim Head of Planning. Just over 50 local people attended with written questions from those unable to attend.

Since the meeting, Lewisham council has carried out a survey on how what's been built compares to the planning permission given. The builder has been asked to remedy issues including the height of the building, cladding, windows and surrounding fences.


