██████████ started rowing in school with an indoor club supported by London Youth Rowing (LYR) I spotted ██████████ an event, run by LYR, and invited her to come along for a taster session on water. She became hooked and has been training with the Globe squad for 2 years. During that time she has developed into an exceptional athlete. In 2015, her first season, she was very successful in terms of progression and came close to winning medals at regional and national level. In 2016 she has won medals at these events and was Bronze Medallist National Schools Championships in quadruple sculling. This is a very high standard of performance and indicates great progress in rowing for her age group. ██████████'s attendance is outstanding, her motivation to succeed shows in every single session and she inspires other members of the squad to achieve their very best. Her prospects for this year are good and she is focusing on GB selection in the Coup de la Jeunesse or the World Rowing Junior Championships. The programme for the above is spread over the season and involves training camps, competitions and trials. All of this comes at a cost to the athlete. Main costs to a rowing athlete and their families are: training camps, competition entries, event and accommodation. As ██████████ progresses through the trials system she will be expected to cover the cost of these various stages and if successful the total outlay for ██████████ is in excess of £4000

I would hate to see ██████████ miss out on exceptional opportunities due to financial reasons.

██████████ has recently given back to London Youth Rowing through volunteering as a coach- showing her determination to inspire others.

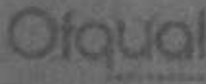
