

At Lewisham Council we are committed to engaging with the Local Community at the local level. For Sydenham, we undertook a survey to capture the views of the residents.



Do you live, work or study in the Sydenham Ward?




On a scale of 1 - 5 (where 1 is least important and 5 is most important) please rank these actions to bring the community together.




- Make sure information gets to everyone in the community in an accessible form

Please tell us how important you think these actions are to promote health and wellbeing in Sydenham?




- Develop Good Neighbour Schemes

How important do you feel these actions are?




- Improving local parks
