The Marriages and Civil Partnerships (approved Premises) Regulations 2005 and Amendment Regulations 2011 state that premises may be approved by the council if in their opinion the following standard requirements are fulfilled:

1. They are a seemly and dignified venue for the proceedings.
2. They are regularly available to the public for use for the registration of civil partnerships (except in so far as section 196 of, and paragraph 2 of schedule 23 to the Equality Act 2010 may apply)
3. They have adequate fire and safety provisions.

The application may be viewed at Lewisham Council, Licensing Authority, 4th Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, SE6 4RU, by appointment only between Monday to Friday (except on public holidays) and between the hours of 9.00 am to 4.00 pm; or at www.lewisham.gov.uk.
