The Policies Map is not defined in statute as a development plan document and so the Inspectors do not have the power to recommend Main Modifications to it.

The role of the Policies Map is to illustrate geographically the application of policies in the plan. Where Main Modifications are proposed to policies within the plan, there may be consequential amendments required for the geographical illustration of the policies. If the geographical illustration of a policy is flawed, the policy will be unsound. In such circumstances, therefore, the Inspectors ask the Council to draw up a proposed change to what is shown on the submission policies map.

The proposed changes to the Policies Map are comprised of range of amendments, corrections and additions to the mapping information that forms part of and supports the new Local Plan.

The following table sets out the proposed changes to the Policies Map for the new Lewisham Local Plan. The table is published to allow those with an interest in the new Local Plan to comment on the proposed changes to the Policies Map (alone).

The proposed changes to the Policies Map are set out in the order that they appear in the new Local Plan. They are identified by their own unique reference number, which is prefixed by the letters PCSPM; and subsequently by their reference point within the new Local Plan, which is the relevant policy and/ or figure number. The proposed changes are identified in the central column cells. Dependent upon the nature of the proposed change, some include a comparison of the existing mapping against the proposed change. The table is completed by a brief commentary that sets out why the change has been proposed. Where appropriate, the commentary identifies the post hearing session Action that generated the proposed change These are identified in brackets – for example (AP7). The post hearing Actions are set out under Examination Document LC39 Consolidated List of Action Points.

In the interests of fairness, the Council is inviting comments on the Policies Map proposed changes document separately, but alongside the consultation on the Main Modifications (and Additional Modifications), for completeness. Those responding to the consultation may only comment on the scope of the proposed changes to the Policies Map. There is no opportunity to comment on other aspects of the new Local Plan that are not identified by a proposed modification or change.

At the end of the consultation process, the Council will collate and consider all of the responses on the proposed changes to the Policies Map. The proposed changes will be made to the Policies Map upon adoption by the Council.
