## Waste and recycling service standards

#### Kerbside

Please help us keep Lewisham clean and safe by following these steps:

- put your bins out before 6am on collection day on the edge of your property, crews are unable to enter the property boundary unless on an assisted collection
- keep bin lids closed to avoid spills and help crews work safely
- only use bins for the correct waste – no black bags, food waste, or general rubbish in recycling bins
- if your recycling bin is full put anything else for recycling in clear bags, card needs to be tied and flattened
- ensure your recycling is clean, and dry (if paper and cardboard)
  – otherwise it will be contaminated and we can't recycle, items like jam jars must be washed thoroughly
- DIY waste, garden and food waste can't go in a general waste bin

- no packaging or liquids in food waste
- put food waste in clear plastic bags, such as bread bags – there is no need to buy expensive biodegradable or compostable bags.
- report missed collections after 2pm and within 48 hours
- park considerately on collection days – blocked access can delay or prevent collections
- let us know if bins are damaged or misused so we can help
- it would really help us if you could number your bins so the crews can return them to your home

#### **Estates**

### Please help us keep Lewisham clean and safe by following these steps:

- bins must be out before 6am on collection day on the edge of your property, or for communal bins at the agreed location
- keep bin lids closed to avoid spills and help crews work safely
- only use bins for the correct waste – no black bags, food waste, or general rubbish in recycling bins
- please make sure your recycling is clean and dry (if paper and cardboard) – otherwise it will be contaminated and we can't recycle it, items like jam jars must be washed thoroughly
- DIY waste and garden waste can't go in a general waste bin
- no packaging or liquids in the food waste
- report missed collections after 2pm and within 48 hours.
- park considerately on collection days – blocked access can delay or prevent collections

- if bins are damaged, misused, lost or stolen – residents need to inform the landlord or managing agent who should contact us
- please keep the areas around the communal bins clear, otherwise the crews can't collect them
