Why is Co-Production Important?

**Key Co-Production Principles:** 

- Everyone is Equal No one is more important than others.
- Respect Each Other –Everyone's ideas matter.
- Work Together Decisions are made as a group.
- Share Power No one person controls everything.
- 5. Be Open and Honest Share ideas and information.
- Support Everyone Help each other to take part.

**How Does Co-Production Work?** 

Talking Together – Having meetings, discussions, and workshops.

Planning Together – Deciding what needs to change.

Doing Together – Taking action and making services better.

Checking Together – Seeing if the changes are working.



Ways to Take Part in Co-Production Join meetings and workshops.

Give feedback on services.

Share your experiences.

Work with staff to improve support.



**What Co-Production is NOT:** 

Consultation (just asking for opinions but not acting on them).

Tick-box exercise (doing it just to say it's done).

One person making all the decisions.
