

Descriptions of tree works

The wording of descriptions must follow these examples:

Example wording for Crown reduction of height, and radius (spread or lateral) reduction:

REAR: ONE Walnut (T3)(ht.15m) CROWN REDUCE HEIGHT by 2m to 13m, REDUCE RADIUS by 2m from 8m to 6m on S compass point. Reason: to retain within garden setting, clearance from building.

Example wording for Height reduction:

FRONT: ONE Acer (T1)(ht.10m) REDUCE HEIGHT by 2m to 8m. Reason: to retain within the garden space

Example wording for Lateral reduction:

FRONT: ONE Holm oak (T2)(ht.15m) LATERAL REDUCTION by 2m from 6m to 4m on N compass point to previous reduction points. Reason: clearance from building

Example wording for Crown thinning:

REAR: ONE Willow (T4)(ht.12-13m) CROWN THIN by 30% (maximum). Reason: to alleviate light issues.

Example wording for Crown Lifting:

REAR: ONE Oak (T3)(ht.15m) CROWN LIFT to 3.5m above ground level. Reason: to provide clearance

Example wording for Re-pollarding:

FRONT: THREE LIME (T1,T2,T3)(ht.16m) RE-POLLARD by 3m to previous pollard points. Reason: repeat maintenance.

Example wording for Felling:

FRONT: ONE Horse Chestnut (T6 in TPO)(ht.14m) FELL. Reason: the tree has died. Duty to replace applies.

REAR: ONE Robinia 'Frisia' (T1)(ht.10m) FELL. Reason: branch failure, main stem basal decay, proximity to rear elevation, health and safety.

Please note:

- Measurements **must** be in metres
- Percentage reductions must only be used to specify crown thinning.
